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Problem

South Africa is facing two major challenges:



Economic recession with dramatic high unemployment rates, esp. amongst youth and female



Just Energy Transition: transformation to a decarbonised economy with significant impacts for employment and qualification needs on the job market



For young South Africans, there are neither sufficient employment prospects nor are they geared to the long-term potential of a largely decarbonised economy (Just Transition).



Generate employment prospects by stimulating the demand side and sectoral orientation on relevant sectors of the just transition

CPD4E builds on the predecessor project SD4GE II and will continue to support the SA TVET system.

The German government is part of the energy partnership which was proclaimed at COP26 supporting SA in JET.



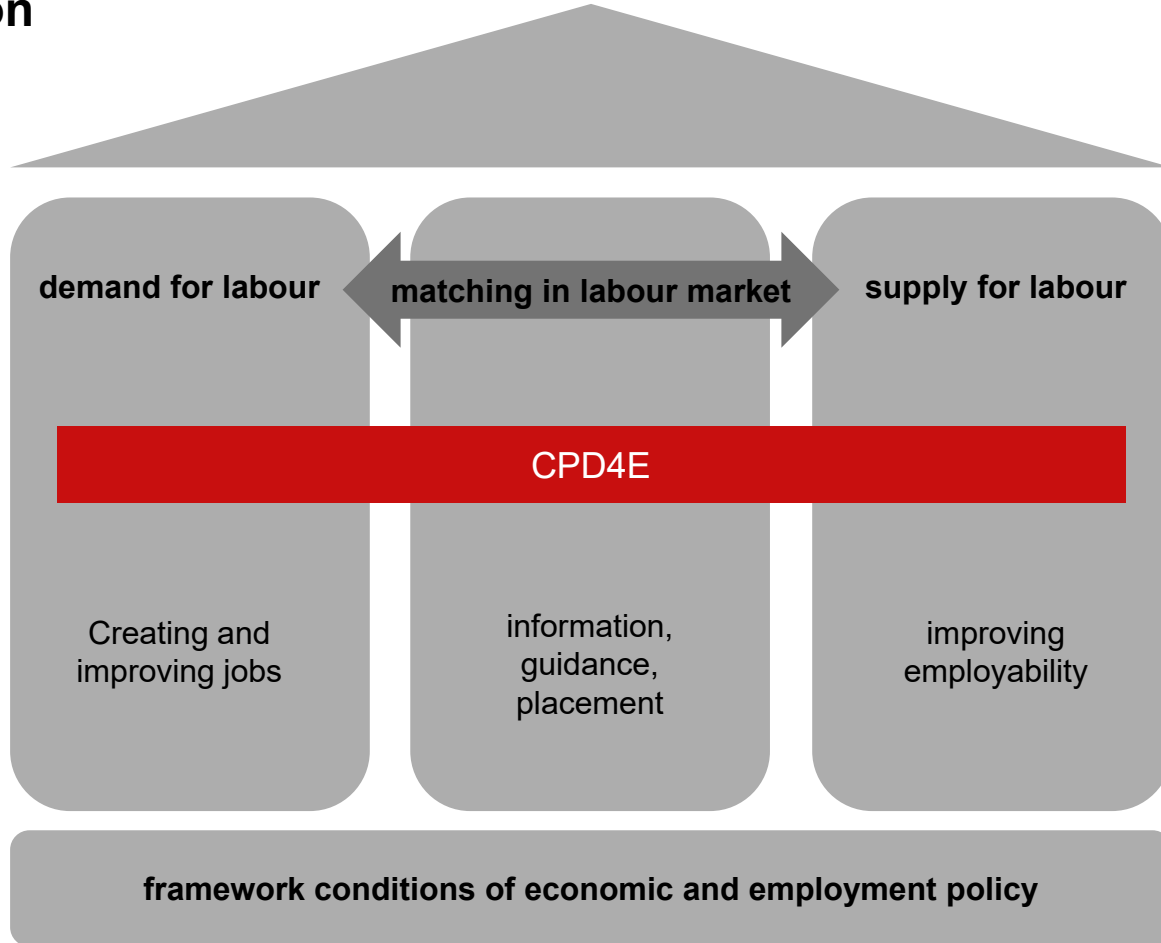

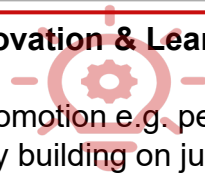

 - Joint identification of **possible implementation partners**
 - Joint **operational planning** for the first year of implementation
- Evaluate and consolidate measures from SD4GE to continue
- Employment and labour market analysis (ELMA) to find out about challenges to employment generation
